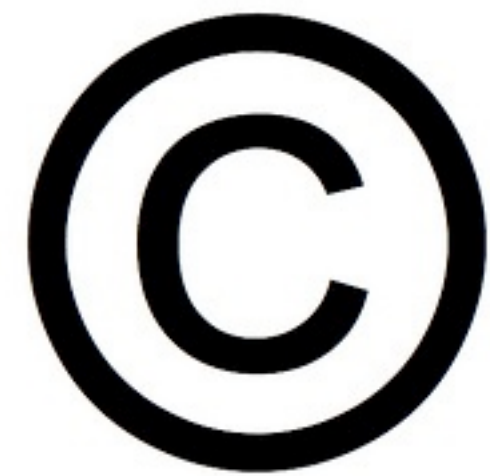


Richards Alphabet book!

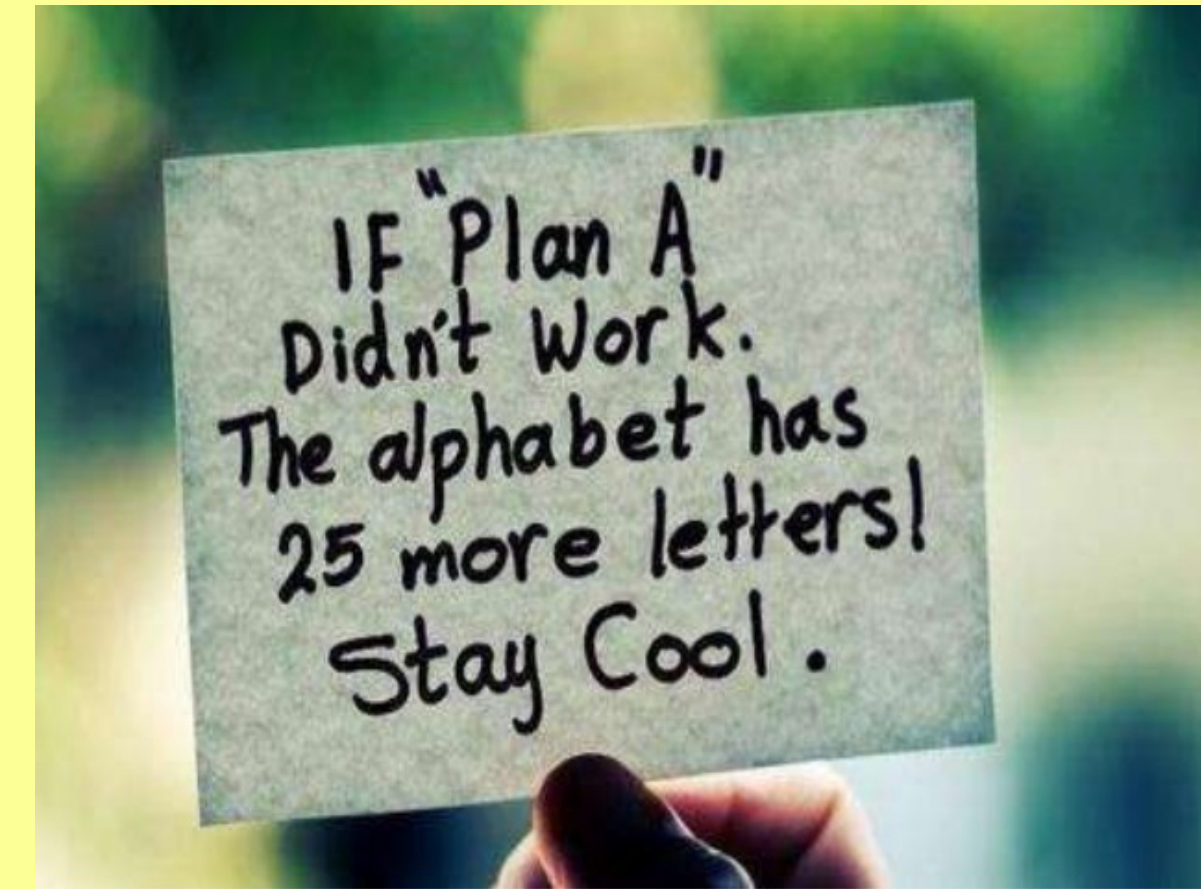
